<b>Demands</b>	All caves are easily accesible, however, ~5 hours stay is planned in Vântului (Wind) Cave and participants should be physically fit enough. The cave is partly equipped (metal ladders) and the route is fairly comfortable for walk. A two hours hike (rather steep hill at the beginning of the trail) is intended to reach the Scărișoara Ice Cave, but car transfer will be provided for those who prefer not to hike.
